DRESS/GROOMING


This tour involves extensive walking and stairs. Wear modest dress (shoulders and knees should be covered for both men and women, women should also have a head covering)

Day Plan: We will meet at a central location and head to the Mount of Olives and Gethsemane to set up the day. We will then work through the archaeology and museums of the Old City and finish the day at Jaffa Gate.

OVERVIEW OF THE DAY AND THEME

This day is focused on the First Century city and the growth of Christianity. The Bible will come to life as we get into the minds and personalities of the Apostles, the High Priest Caiaphas and even Pontus Pilate with the backdrop of the archaeology from that time period.

The program can also be adapted for a pilgramige focus, which would replace some of the archaeology with visits to Church of the Holy Sepulchre and other notable traditional sites.
