Focus: Israelite period (Late Bronze, Iron Age) archaeology

Sites Visited: Tel Bet Shemesh, Khirbet Qeiyafa, Tel Lachish

**Lunch Options:** Simple Israeli lunch (falafel or shawarma) or an Israeli charcuterie style lunch at a boutique winery.

Day Plan: We'll leave the hotel at 8:00am and drive to the Judean Hills and Coastal Plain (Shephelah). We will visit various sites important to Biblical history and examine famous Biblical history against the backdrop of archaeology and secular history.

# **OVERVIEW OF THE DAY AND THEME**

The Philistines played a pivotal role in the Israelite history. So we will examine their relationship with Israel during the time of the Judges and Samuel from the ruins of Tel Bet Shemesh and the Sorek Valley. From there we will head to Qeiyafa which looks over the Elah Valley to consider the Philistine's relations with Saul and David, and the famous showdown with Goliath.

After a lunch break, we will continue south to Lachish and discuss the war between Judean King Hezekiah and Sennacherib of Assyria and what the motivation was behind Assyria's invasion.

As we return to the hotel/drop off we will take in the scenery and landscape of other sites mentioned in the Bible, this may include Maresha and Gath.
