Tour Description:

We meet and depart from Haifa at 7:30am. We drive along the Hula Valley and reach the foothills of Mount Hermon where we begin at the Tel Dan Nature Reserve. In this ancient Biblical city we will explore the Canaanite and Israelite ruins, learn about the archaeological findings from the site that are described in the Bible, and also consider what motivated the Danites to leave their inheritance and settle in this area (Jg 18).

We will stop for lunch at the Agamon Hula Market. There we have options for a quick meal that we can eat on the go (like a falafel or shawarma), or we can sit down for about 45 minutes to eat.

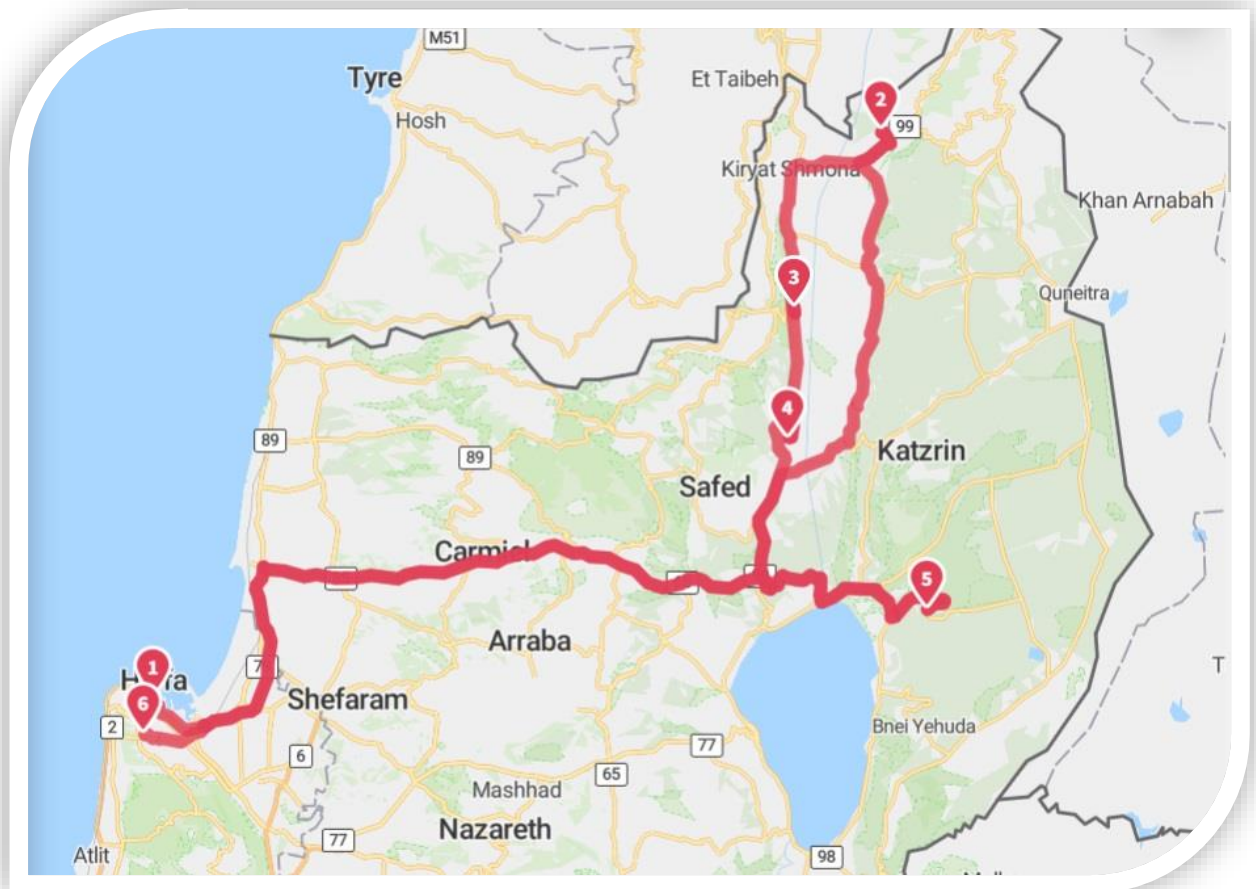
After lunch, it is a short drive to Tel Hazor, where we will consider the Canaanite system of governance and the fall of the city to Joshua and later also to Barak (Jos 11:10-15; Jg 4).

We finish the day at the Beit Tzaida Observation Point where we will discuss the Geshurites and David's role in how Israel was finally able to absorb their land (the modern Golan Heights) into the Israelite Kingdom. We return back to Haifa after this or you can leave the guide near Tiberias and remain in the area.
